






- iii. List six guidelines that the dental assistant should take into account when doing chart/record entries as a legal record. (6)



- i. You are requested to provide home care instructions to a mother whose child has had an extraction. Describe the information you will give this mother. (4)
- ii. You are asked to advise an elderly patient to care for her dentures (full upper and lower).

 The patient is partially deaf. Describe the information to be given and the method you would use to ensure that the patient understands you.
