SUBMISSION OF PAIA ANNUAL REPORTS TO THE INFORMATION REGULATOR

The Information Regulator has issued a notice for Heads of Private Bodies or their Deputy Information Officers to submit to the Regulator, their Annual Reports about requests for access to records received and processed by the private body.

The Regulator has developed an online portal for submission of annual reports which portal can be accessed on the Regulator website, <https://inforegulator.org.za>, or by going directly to the Regulator eServices portal, accessible on <https://eservices.inforegulator.org.za>. Please note that the portal for submission of access to information Annual Reports will be live from **01 May 2024** and the submission of the said annual reports will close on **30 June 2024**.

Please also note that you will not be able to submit your annual report unless you are registered as an Information Officer with the Regulator.
