SADA Advisory: Additional Amalgam Separator Options and Cost Overview for Dental Practices

Background

All dental practices are legally required under the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment (DFFE) regulations to install and maintain an amalgam separator to prevent mercury contamination. This is a compliance obligation, not a voluntary measure. As requested by SADA members, the following provides a summary of available suppliers (other than DRI-SA), associated pricing, maintenance requirements, installation provisions, and recycling options to support members in making informed procurement decisions. Kindly note that many of the options presented below have recently come to the fore in light of the awareness that has been created.

Dentist's Responsibility

Each practice owner that either places or removes amalgam restorations or extracts teeth that contain amalgam restorations is responsible for:

- Acquiring and installing a compliant amalgam separator.
- Ensuring regular maintenance and safe disposal of amalgam waste through an accredited waste handler.
- Retaining proof of disposal (certificate of destruction) for inspection if requested by authorities.
- Securing a replacement amalgam separator while the initial one is sent to A-Thermal for cleaning, which is a process that typically takes a few months to complete.

Option 1: Eco II+

- Price: R40,000 (SADA members qualify for 10% discount until December 2025)
- Maintenance: Annual canister replacement at ± R9,500
- Installation: Free (excluding travel and accommodation outside Gauteng)
- Recycling: Available at additional cost

Option 2: Cattani Hydrocyclone ISO-6 Amalgam separator

- Price: R16102.50
- Maintenance:
 - 3rd year costs R1932.30
 - 4th year costs R2145.38

- 7th year costs R4669.73

Disposal and Recycling

To date, A-Thermal is the only waste management company that has been accredited by the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment for the safe disposal of dental amalgam using thermal treatment. Once this is carried out, they will issue the member with a certificate of destruction.

Typically, the amalgam separator is cleaned, checked and returned to the practice, however this process could take up to several months therefore it is recommended that replacement separators are available as part of the service offering from the supplier. The chairside amalgam bucket will be destroyed entirely and will require replacement.



Failure to comply with DFFE's Waste Management Regulations constitutes a breach of environmental law and may result in penalties. Practices must ensure that the separator used meets the **ISO 11143** standard for amalgam retention.
