# INVITATION TO SADA MEMBERS TO AVAIL YOURSELF FOR NOMINATION - HPCSA MEDICAL AND DENTAL PROFESSIONS BOARD (2025-2030 TERM)

We advise that the **Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA)** has opened the **call for nominations** to serve on its **Professional Boards for the 2025–2030 term**.

As a valued member of the dental profession, we invite you to avail yourself for nomination to the Medical and Dental Professions Board, which has five (5) seats available for dentists and one (1) seat for a dentist representing the universities with faculties or schools of dentistry, who shall be appointed by Higher Education South Africa (HESA) (now Universities South Africa) (USAf) to represent universities with faculties or schools of dentistry; a representative on behalf of universities. This is a vital

opportunity for you to contribute to the regulation, advancement, and integrity of the dental profession in South Africa.

The HPCSA Professional Boards play a critical role in protecting the public and guiding registered health practitioners in line with national health objectives. Members appointed to these Boards by the **Minister of Health** will serve a **five-year term** commencing from **1 November 2025**.

- Eligibility: Nominees must be health practitioners actively registered with the HPCSA

# THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT MERCURY REGULATIONS IN SOUTH AFRICA

As South Africa moves forward with mercury waste regulations, dental practices must understand the requirements and how to comply. These regulations, part of South Africa's commitment as a signatory to the Minamata Treaty, have been released by the DFFE and are in effect now.



### 1. REGULATIONS IN EFFECT NOW

The South African government released the finalized regulations on March 31, 2025 and all regulations are currently in effect. These regulations aim to ensure that dental practices properly manage and dispose of mercury waste to prevent environmental contamination.

### 2. DRI-SA PROGRAM FOR SADA MEMBERS
