After passing the MCQ with a score of a minimum of 70%, you will receive an email with your Certificate and a copy of your submission's answer sheet. The answer sheet is especially useful if you do not attain a perfect score. Please note that we will be adding historical SADJ multiple-choice questions.

You are responsible for printing and/or storing the certificate you receive; SADA cannot retrieve a copy of the certificate on your behalf. Please note that, per HPCSA guidelines, you have only two opportunities to complete a multiple-choice question.

SADA will submit every month the extract for the preceding month's completed MCQs to the HPCSA as per requirement.

Earning CEUs for a formal qualification

On point 3, the HPCSA guidelines state the following:

2.2 Level 2: This level comprises structured learning, i.e., a formal programme that is planned and offered by an accredited training institution, evaluated by an accredited assessor and has a measurable outcome.

Activities include: (No prior approval by an accreditor necessary)

(a) postgraduate degrees, diplomas, and certificates that are recognized as additional qualifications by the relevant professional board – at the end of each year of study (not exceeding the normal duration of the degree); thirty CEUs may be claimed upon submitting an academic report on progress, and additional thirty CEUs may be claimed on successful completion of the qualification;

NB – Ignore what I said in the webinar on Tuesday the 27th of June 2023. Any formal qualification must NOT be submitted to SADA but directly with the HPCSA as per the attached guide for both SADA and Non-SADA members.

What to do if your provider has not submitted your CPD activity schedule Points

At SADA, we prioritize the seamless submission of your face-to-face or virtual meeting CPD activities. Rest assured; we are committed to submitting these activities within 10 days of their occurrence. Additionally, for your SADJ MCQ activity, we will ensure its submission on the 1st of the month or the closest working day thereafter. However, if you have attended a CPD event outside of SADA and you find that the service provider has not submitted it, we've got you covered. Simply refer to the attached manual, which outlines the steps for you to directly submit it to the HPCSA. Your professional growth matters to us, and we're here to support you every step of the way!

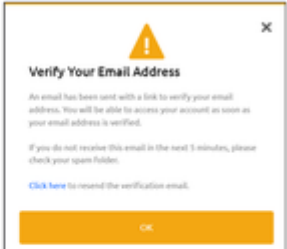


Creating/Activating a Glue Up Account via Desktop or Laptop using the SADA Website
