- As we transitioned from SADA's former website (www.sada.co.za ), which was managed by E2 Solutions, to Glue Up, we have been diligently cross-checking all existing information and systematically uploading new content for our members.
- We are pleased to report that significant progress has been achieved in the loading and updating of all links. Our goal is to have all documentation and links available by the end of November, ensuring a seamless experience for our members.

## **EARNING CEUS THROUGH SADJ**

- Initially, SADJ online MCQ access was provided through links distributed via the SADArite to members.
- To enhance accessibility, we have now relocated all these links directly to the website menu item Professional Resources - Continuing Professional Development - Earn CEUs on the website.
- To access the SADJ MCQs, please visit <a href="https://www.sada.co.za/earn-ceus">https://www.sada.co.za/earn-ceus</a> and select the specific MCQ link for the SADJ for which you'd like to complete an MCQ.
- You'll be directed to FlexiQuiz, where the MCQs are hosted. Please ensure you fill in your details (including your professional number) to proceed with the MCQ.

- Upon successfully completing an MCQ with a minimum score of 70%, you will earn the corresponding CEUs and receive a confirmation email along with your certificate. Please retain this certificate for your records
- SADA will compile all CPD activities from the SADJ on the 1st of each month for the previous month
  and submit them to the HPCSA for recording. We have no influence on how long the HPCSA takes to
  load

#### **CPD SUBMISSION TO THE HPCSA**

- In alignment with HPCSA regulations, SADA ensures that all CPD activities it offers, encompassing online SADJ MCQs, attendance at Branch events, and participation in Online events, are compiled and transmitted to the HPCSA:
  - All CEU activities (except the SADJ MCQ activities) are submitted within 10 days of the respective events.
  - SADJ MCQ activities are collated and submitted on the 1st of each month for the previous month.
- Notably, attendance data for the 2023 SADA Dental & Oral Health Congress and Exhibition was forwarded to the HPCSA on September 15, 2023.
- The HPCSA has communicated the existence of a backlog in processing this information and encourages practitioners to be patient as they work through their submissions.
- Nevertheless, if any SADA member wishes to inquire about the submissions made to the HPCSA for SADA-hosted events, they may reach out to SADA for clarification.
- Registered practitioners who attend CPD activities can access their cumulative CPD points status through their online HPCSA profiles, which is also the platform where all submissions are made.
- If you have attended a non-SADA CPD activity, it is advisable to contact the organizer or host of that event for information and updates.
